Throughout southern Queensland, soil management has become a major challenge for infrastructure construction and environmental management. Issues include subsoil salinity and sodicity, compaction, hardsetting and susceptibility to surface and tunnel erosion. These issues have the potential to greatly increase costs of construction, erosion control, site rehabilitation and maintenance, and may affect compliance with site licenses.
