These courses cover legislative requirements under the Planning and Environment Act (Victorian Planning Provisions: 56.08) and the EPA Act Victoria. They are also endorsed by EPA Victoria with an officer attending for an hour to address site issues.

Vic Roads recommends that personnel implementing EMP's or installing control measures undertake this training or an equivalent course.

On successful completion of these competencies participants receive a Certificate of Completion credit towards the Cert II in Conservation and Land Management and a Green Card.
